## VII. CMAS Underwater Rugby Open European Championship for Juniors (U21) “Stuttgart 2010”

The German Underwater Federation has the pleasure of inviting you to the VII. CMAS Underwater Rugby Open European Championship for Juniors (U 21).

In order to organise the event in due time, we ask you to return the **Intent of Participation** form (see enclosure “Intent of Participation”) by:

**30<sup>th</sup> September 2010**

- Governing body:** C.M.A.S.  
**Hosting Federation:** VDST e.V. – Verband Deutscher Sporttaucher e.V.
- Rules:**  
The international UWR rules of C.M.A.S. (December 2008) apply.
- Players:**  
Players born in 1990 or later may participate in the championship. All players shall bring a valid ID to be shown at request.
- Protest:**  
All written protest must be delivered to the jury of the championship (according to Rule 2.1.4) not later than 30 min. after the respective game is ended. **Protest fee is 50.00 EUR.**
- Referee**  
One international referee from each participating Federation will be refereeing the games. Each Federation shall cover the transportation/travel cost for the referee from their own Federation.  
C.M.A.S. UWR Chief Referee will in conjunction with each Federation select participating referees.  
The referee schedule will be managed by the C.M.A.S. UWR Chief Referee.

6. **Limitation of liability**

Participation of athletes and national delegations in the CMAS UW-Rugby Open European Championship for Juniors will be at one's own responsibility.  
The hosting federation will not be liable for any personal or material damages.


**Last day of payment : 30<sup>th</sup> September 2010**
