3. Executive team of the tournament

The organiser appoints the executive team of the tournament in advance.

4. Rules and scoring

4.1 Rules

All games will be played in compliance with the CMAS/VDST underwater rugby

regulations and the VDST doping restrictions.

4.2 Scoring

In case of equal scores, the position will be determined by the following order:

1. direct comparison of the two respective teams,
2. goal difference from all games (except preliminary round),
3. total goals from all games (except the preliminary round).

If the above given order can still not provide a final result, the two respective teams will hold a penalty shoot-out (three players per team alternately, then one player per team to the final result, one further try included.)

5. Entry

If one club would like to enter two teams, each player is allowed to play for one of those two teams only. The tournament is open to national and international club teams. The players of national teams or united teams must be members of VDST, those of international teams must be members of CMAS.

6. Referees

The games will be conducted by A- or B-squad referees. We would appreciate if all teams could provide referees. We strive for working with external referees.

The organiser will provide oxygen bottles, regulators and weights. Protection suits against cold have to be organised by the referees themselves.

7. Draw, play time, playing system

Playing schedules and the playing system will be distributed via e-mail after the deadline. The fixtures will be drawn on Friday, November 4th, 2011 at the club house of TSC Mülheim, Großenbaumerstr. 149a, Germany at 20:00 pm.

New regulations:

International teams and **female teams** can register united teams for the **Goldenen Ball** and **Silbernen Ball**.

Prerequisite is that they are not registered under the regulations of the VDST. For German teams the current (last, valid) team squad according to the players' licences is valid. If a player has not been registered for any team in the running season 2010/2011, he is available for any team of his choice.

8. Teams

A maximum of 16 teams can play the tournament. The regulations as stipulated in section no. 5 and 7 are valid.

9. Appeals

Appeals have to be made verbally to the executive team by the team captain immediately after awareness of the reason and to be submitted in writing 30 minutes after the end of the game. The executive team will charge 50,- € for each appeal. The executive team decides upon the appeal, and their decision is incontestable. If the appeal is not accepted, the paid appeal fee lapses for the benefit of the organiser.

10. Exclusion of liability

The participation in this tournament takes place at one's own risk. The TSC Mülheim e.V. does not take any liability for personal or property damages of any kind.

11. Declaration of acceptance

Submitting your entry, the registered teams and players accept all sections of this invitation.
