

Game and playing schedule for European Championship 2005

Game and playing schedule for 10 male team and 6 female team. **See enclosure 3**

Training session in the pool: Monday 6 June 2005

Opening Ceremony: Tuesday morning 7 June 2005

Games will start: Tuesday afternoon 7 June 2005

Finales will be: Saturday 11 June 2005

Women:

Qualification Round for women:

All team will play one match against each other

In the semi-finale will:

No.1 from the qualification round plays against no.4 from the qualification round

No.2 from the qualification round plays against no.3 from the qualification round

The winner of the two semi-finals will meet each other in the final.

The losers will play for ranks 3 and 4.

If 7 or more women team will participate the teams will be divided into two groups.

Ranking of the women team will necessary before draw for the two groups.

Level 1: Germany and Norway (no.1 and 2 from the last EC)

This means that Germany and Norway cannot be in the same group for the qualification round!

Level 2: Sweden and Denmark (no.3 last EC and Denmark which was no. 5 in the last WC in 2003)

This means that Sweden and Denmark cannot be in the same group for the qualification round!

Level 3 All other team will be placed by draw in the two groups.

Men:

There will be two Groups for men if there are between 8 and 12 team sign in for the European Championship.

Draw for group 1 and 2

Ranking for the teams are as follows:

Level 1: Sweden and Finland (no.1 and 2 from the last EC)

This means that Sweden and Finland cannot be in the same group for the qualification round!

Level 2: Norway and Germany (no.3 and 4 from the last EC)

This means that Norway and Germany cannot be in the same group for the qualification round!

Level 3: Denmark and Czech (no.5 and 6 last EC)

This means that Denmark and Czech cannot be in the same group for the qualification round!

Level 4 All other team will be placed by draw in the two groups.

After the qualification round no.1 from both Group no.1 and no.2 will be in the semi-finals.

No.2 from Group 1 will meet no.3 from Group 2. They will play for a place in the semi-finals against the winner of Group 2

No.2 from Group 2 will meet no.3 from Group 1. They will play for a place in the semi-finals against the winner from Group 1

The two losers for the above mention games will play for ranking 5 and 6

No.4 from Group 1 will meet no.4 from Group 2 for ranking 7 and 8

No.5 from group 1 will meet no.5 from group 2 for ranking 9 and 10
