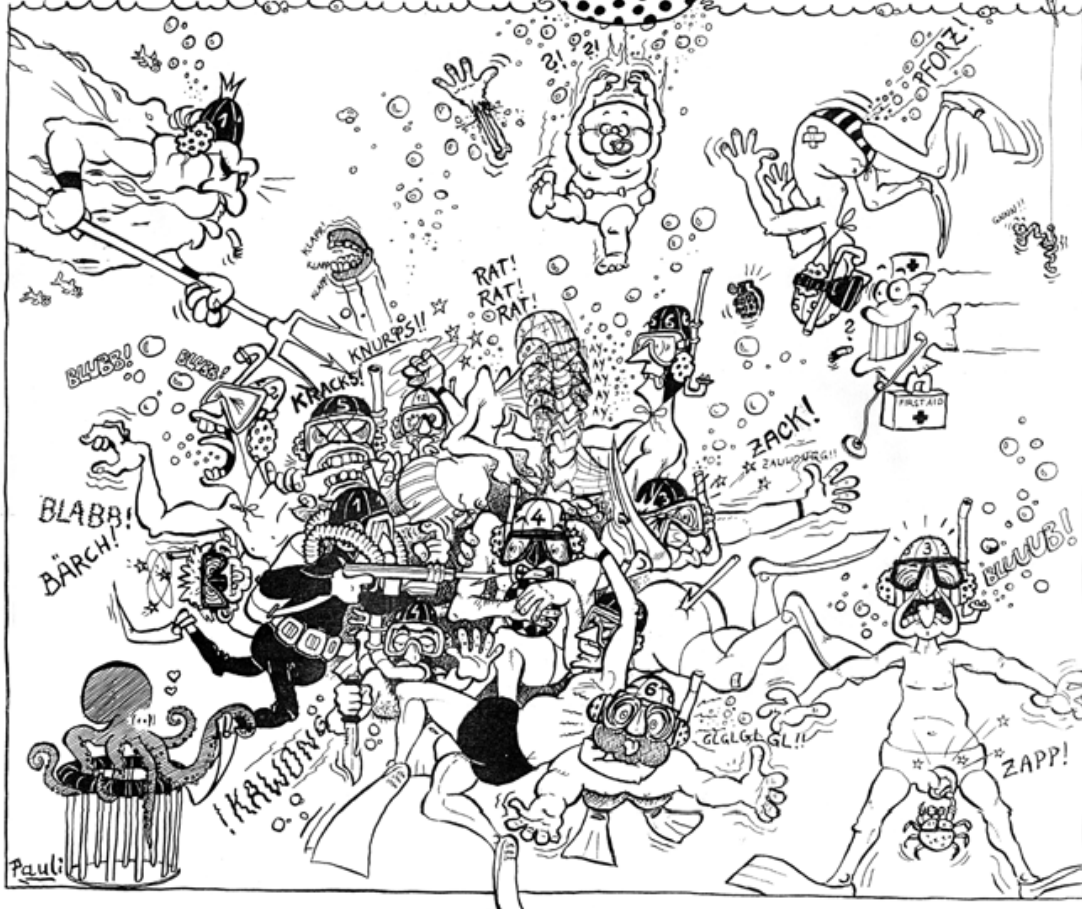

5. TEAMS/ COMPETITORS

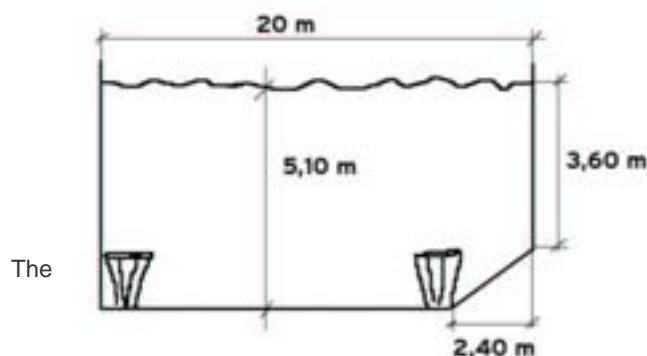
One team consists of 11 players an 4 substitutes.

At most 12 teams are allowed to take part in this tournament. (the team of the STEIRISCHE PANTHER included) Representative teams are also accepted.

6. RULES

The official rules of the CMAS are valid during the tournament. The way and the time of playing depend on the number of the teams, who take part in the competiton. The sequence of playing will be defined at the conference of the team leaders.

7. FIELD



The tournament takes part in the diving pool of the open-air swimming pool.

Dimensions of the field:
Length: 20 m
Breadth: 12 m
Depth: 3.60 - 5,10 m

8. REFEREE

Every Team has to have two referees with a valid licence for the year 2004.
A fee of 25,- € will be charged for every missing referee.

9. ADMINISTRATION OF THE TOURNAMENT

The administration is introduced at the open-air swimming pool.

10. PROTESTS

Protests have to be placed up to 30 minutes after the match on paper by the teamcaptain at the administration.

11. PRESENTATION CEREMONY

The presentation ceremony is held at about one hour after the last game. The place of the ceremony is announced at the conference of the team leaders.

12. LIABILITY

If there is no insurance coverage, the teams participate at their own risk.

The organizer and the administration don't accept any liability.
