Items raised during the “Manoeuvre Critic” meeting after the
7th E.C. in Sandefjord (N) on June 9th 2001

What was good and what should be improved on the next event?

- o All participants congratulated the local organiser on the nearly perfect and smoothly going organisation.
- o Work of the referee teams was considered very good.
- o Local organiser was highly satisfied with the tournament since help to him was received from all sides.
- o Quality of video filming and display on screen done by the friends of the Check Rep. was considered excellent. During the days all games were enthusiastically watched by many people.
- o The organiser had to do extremely much extra work since the requested photos from the participating teams arrived much to late or had to be taken at the spot. Photos must be made available in time requested.
- o ► The communication flow between the federations and the organiser in future must be speeded up considerably to avoid stress situations for the organiser.
- o ► Lodging of a team should be organised on the same floor so that the rooms for the team members are not scattered over the place.
Consequence: Rooms (special orders) for people not directly belonging to the team have to organised differently.
- o ► Much more attention must be given to promotion actions (propaganda, flags, placates, press, TV etc.). Such tournaments are the best opportunities to focus the public on UWR sport events.
- o ► Any information through the paging system in the swimming pool area/cafeteria must be transmitted loudly and clearly enough so that it can be understood also in the remotest corners.
- o Execution of free throws should be started by the referees as fast as possible.
- o In future the game protocols should be filled in manually at the control desk since they are important documents which should not be possible to change after the event.
- o For discussing game decisions or situations it was suggested to have a video/TV set available. This tool could help to improve understanding between players, coaches and referees.
- o Package with diplomas and medals arrived to late.
